WOODCHURCH WINDMILL UPDATE

The long awaited repairs and repaint to the mill are still planned to go ahead starting in April but will now have to include repairs to the damaged sail which was brought down in a severe gust of wind several weeks ago. The wind was only partly responsible for the damage - the main timber backbone of the sail had completely rotted. We are in discussions with Ashford Borough Council regarding a specific timber condition survey on the sails to see how widespread the deterioration may be and, subsequently, how much remedial work is required.

With all the above works we are currently unable to predict how long they will take and, therefore, cannot plan the opening days (and the schedule for our volunteers) until we have more information.
