The "Woodchurch Hub"

With the lead up to the launch of the Woodchurch Minibus service planned for the end of June/beginning of July (now officially named by the children at the school "The Woodchurch Wagon") we will be relaunching the Woodchurch Information Centre to provide longer, more regular, opening hours during the week. We will also be renaming it the "**Woodchurch Hub**" to reflect its more central role within the village.

We will continue to provide the same services to the village that we have over the past 4 years however we will be expanding these to include:

- Regular opening hours 10 am to 4 pm Monday to Friday, and 10 am to 1 pm on Saturdays
- Working closer with the Parish Council to help keep you informed about what is happening within the village
- Coordination of the Woodchurch Wagon minibus hire
- Central village calendar event management
- Maintaining the village club/society directory
- Coordination point for village publication and leaflet delivery
- Central ticketing sales for all clubs and societies
- Social media promotion for village events (e.g. Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Next Door etc.)
- Noticeboard management throughout the village
- Tourist Information

We will, of course, continue to provide photocopying and lamination services, and produce the monthly Newsletter to help keep you informed about what is going on, complimenting the information in the Parish Magazine.

We already have several additional volunteers come forward to help us develop the Hub, however we are looking for more. We are looking for a wide range of skills and this could include, to help staff the Hub opening for a few hours per week/month (either regularly or on the reserve standby list), help coordinate advertising and promotion of village events, manage the village calendar and club/society directory, help with social media management or help develop and manage the new Web site. Whatever your skills and comfort levels you can make a contribution to the successful running of The Woodchurch Hub.

Training will be available for all volunteers. 
