Woodchurch Community Calendar

societies in Woodchurch and is being managed through the Information Centre. At a glance you can see what is going on in the village on any day, week, month or for the whole year. If you choose, the calendar can also automatically email you the list of events on a regular basis. In addition to accessing the calendar through the Web sites, you can also be kept fully up to date on your smartphone or tablet by using the "Teamup Calendar" app – available free of charge in both the Apple and Android App Stores.
