Woodchurch Village Life Museum - 150+ Club

Our Museum, which is nestled at the bottom of Susans Hill, is a wonderful source of local history. It is open every weekend and public holiday from Easter to September and entrance is free. Although the Museum is run by volunteers it relies entirely on fundraising to pay for its maintenance, restoration,



electricity, insurance, rates etc. The museum has therefore been running a 150+ club for many years to help cover its operational costs and there are currently 10 tickets remaining for the 2019/20 draws. For £12 a year you have 4 numbers entered into each monthly draw with the chance of winning one of more of the monthly prizes (£50, £30, £20, £15, £10). Although the draws began in October there are still 10 tickets available to enter and these will be available to buy at the hub for £10 - to cover the remaining 10 months. 


A BUMPER CHRISTMAS ORGAN CONCERT
