Woodchurch Windmill Update

Ashford Borough Council (the owners of Woodchurch Windmill) have been seeking advice from local Millwrights so that the full extent of the required repairs can be assessed. Initial reports indicate that the total cost of the repairs may approach £200,000, which could delay the completion of the work until 2035. The Parish Council have agreed to work with The Friends of Woodchurch Windmill to discuss options with ABC to see if this work can be brought forward and whether additional independent fundraising could help speed up the restoration.

Church Floodlights

Following the very successful online appeal in December to reinstate the floodlights around All Saints Church, the lights were switched on for the first time in over 10 years on Christmas Eve.



Whilst the illumination ceremony was taking place, Paul Taylor (aka Johnny Quo) was holding a fundraising BingQuo inside the Bonny Cravat to raise money to help with the ongoing running costs for the lights.
