COVID-19 Central Support in Woodchurch – Woodchurch Working Together...


- We are here to co-ordinate help for anyone in the village please get in contact.
- Support at this time is being coordinated nationally between Central Government, KCC, Borough and local councils and the community sector. Any calls made to national or regional support numbers are being passed to the most appropriate local support group to provide the physical support. Requests relating to Woodchurch will be passed down to our village Support Hotline Team but it will **be quicker to access** us directly on 01233 801 789. - Calls or emails to the Village Central Support Hotline will be picked up by our village Hotline Helpdesk Team who will then coordinate with one of our volunteers to support and complete the task.

Woodchurch Surgery is not closed, rather their doors are locked.

- The surgery has now gone live with **eConsult** which is accessed via a link on their website <u>www.woodchurchsurgery.co.uk</u>. This will enable patients to get general advice, clinical advice and ask for administrative help online.
- Alternatively, patients can **call the Surgery on 01233 860236** if they have a medical problem that they need to discuss as everything is being triaged first. Their call will be returned and the clinician will determine if a face to face appointment is necessary or suitable. If it is, an appointment will be made.
- <u>www.woodchurchsurgery.co.uk</u> has links to the latest Covid-19 guidance including to obtaining a self-isolation note. If patients have difficulty collecting their prescriptions the Surgery can arrange delivery. As an interim measure during this crisis, a **dispensary closure between 1 and 2pm** has been introduced to allow for re-stocking.
