Pandemic Central Support in Woodchurch – Woodchurch Working Together...

- Calls or emails to the Village Central Support Hotline will be picked up by our village Hotline Helpdesk Team who will then coordinate with one of our volunteers to support and complete the task.

It is not only the elderly and vulnerable who are being seriously affected as the lockdown continues

With the support already in place within the village to help the vulnerable and self-isolating residents manage during the lockdown, we are now ensuring that we are ready to support families who may become seriously impacted in other ways. As the restrictions continue some village residents may suddenly find themselves in a critical situation - for example where a family finds the primary wage earner has lost their income without being eligible for the government Furlough scheme and has therefore suddenly lost their only source of family income. Finding yourself in this situation can be distressing and it can be difficult to know what to do. If you are in this position, **please contact the Support Line** - and if you know of someone who is affected **please encourage them to phone**. All calls are treated in the strictest of confidence. Whilst the Support Line cannot provide any direct financial assistance there are grants and funding available from several sources (including one only available to Woodchurch residents) that may be able to assist through these unprecedented times. Please don't forget that we also have the **Woodchurch Foodbank** which is already helping some of the residents who are most in need.

Woodchurch Surgery is **not closed**, **rather their doors are locked**. The surgery has now gone live with **eConsult** which is accessed via a link on their website <u>www.woodchurchsurgery.co.uk</u>. Alternatively, patients can **call the Surgery on 01233 860 236**. If patients have difficulty collecting their prescriptions the Surgery can arrange delivery.

Shopping - For those that do have to go out for essential items or have an online shop please remember to look out for your neighbours (particularly those self-isolating and without internet access) and see if you can add extra items for them.
