- <u>Woodchurch Community Speedwatch</u> team are now once again able to monitor the speed of traffic in our village and will be starting from Monday 27 June. All activity was previously suspended in light of Government requirements regarding groups of people meeting. In the first instance the locations we can operate from have been limited as part of the reintroduction programme. The aim of Speedwatch is not to catch people out but remind motorists of the speed limit in our village and create an ongoing awareness for the need to observe it. - The Friends of Woodchurch Windmill ('FOWW') F the smock building




benefited from a complete overhaul and repaint in July 2019 and is looking splendid. It continues to be illuminated several hours every night – as one of the village beacons. FOWW continue to work with the Parish Council to liaise with Ashford Borough Council (who owns the windmill) on the programme for reinstatement of the sails and will resume discussions in due course. Even though you are currently not able to go inside the smock please take the opportunity to walk up to the mill on the newly surfaced footpath (thank you Kent County Council!). Two village footpaths follow this route
