Summary of outputs from our Meeting 12.1.23

• **Mobile advertising cart**—Following our last 2 meetings, it has been decided to invest in a cart that is manoeuverable for groups to put flyers on. Eg This could be placed at well known meeting points or even at an event, allowing people access to information for forthcoming events in the Village

We explained to attendees that the sum of **£100.00** would cover the purchase and adaption to a cart - those attending agreed this was a good opportunity for groups to chip in and fund.

Looking at the directory on the Hub site, there are 31 organisations—if all groups paid **£3.50** this would cover the purchase and allow this asset to be developed.
