### WOODCHURCH SURGERY UPDATE

The slight downer I felt last month about the uncertainty of vaccines has been transformed to a buzzing, positive vibe about getting on with the winter. We were in total limbo about the contractual agreements around covid and then had no idea if we would get the vaccines in before our freefor-all on Saturday 16th September.

We had our flu vaccines delivered on the 14th and on lunchtime on the Friday 15th Covid jabs arrived by the plentiful. I parked up the road to keep the car park free and on walking down the road was greeted by a very happy mob IT'S VACCINATION

100 deep waiting for the 8am start. The positive atmosphere was amazing and at the same time all our nightmares came true - a queue!

With 5 people vaccinating, and lots helping, we soon reduced the queue and just kept on jabbing. Before we knew it we had completed 500 flu and covid jabs. It was pretty intense but really rewarding and we all felt a bit jubilant. The great news is that we are doing it all again on Saturday 7th October. There are currently 180 Covid positive in the William Harvey and plenty of cases in the community so come and get protected as much as you can.

Sadly, we are losing one of our reception team. Perrie has been with us for 2 years but as family life moves on she is moving to a job closer to home with more suitable hours. She has been a great part of the team and has left her mark so we will all miss her but wish her well.

However, we welcome new medical students starting again with us in October. They will be a mix of year 1 and 2 students and we are grateful for the time that you give them. We are enthusiastic about the Medical School in the hope that if we give them a good experience they will stay in Kent and one day be GPs here. With jobs in Oz and elsewhere looking attractive we plan to hit them early with dreams of life in Woodchurch so please help them dream big!

Our very own Lead Nurse Sarah is now looking to expand her skills by doing a Clinical Skills course that leads into an Independent Prescriber degree. You may see her popping up in consultations with GPs looking to build on her experience and I'm sure that you will welcome her and show off any murmurs or unusual skin things etc.

September has been very positive with lots going on and I hope that we are giving you the best version of what we can do for you all. I look forward to the 7th October and seeing as many of you as possible that haven't been vaccinated with flu or Covid. There are cohorts, but really we would prefer you to come along and if possible get immunised than wonder if you deserve to be part of the gang.



# WOODCHURCH WOMEN'S INSTITUTE

On a balmy, September evening Anne Bauling braved the most recent roadworks in Front Road and arrived safely at the Memorial Hall from Rye in good time to deliver her inspirational talk entitled "Supershoes - Empowering Children through the Difficult Journey of Cancer" and we were all thrilled that she did, as the subject matter proved to be both sad, and uplifting!

Anne explained that the Co-founders of the Supershoes Charity were Sarah and Ken White and they formed the Charity, based in Milton Keynes, Bucks., to raise awareness of childhood cancer and to improve the well-being of affected children and their families. Sarah and Ken are ably supported in their efforts by a



Of course, childhood cancer is extremely rare - around 1,800 new cases are diagnosed every year in the UK for children aged 0-14 years. This means that childhood cancers account for less than 1% of all cancers in the UK; slightly more for boys (990 new cases in 2016-2018) compared to girls in the UK (840 in the same time period).

Any child/young person in the UK up to the age of 24 with a cancer diagnosis is eligible for a one-off gift of a uniquely decorated pair of Converse Trainers (For a referral, contact Young Lives Vs Cancer on 0300 303 5220). Supershoes make every effort to ensure that each pair of shoes is unique and personal to each particular child. This is achieved by involving the recipient in the initial design and colouring of the shoes, for example the child might want to feature their pets or a favourite game, or TV/Film characters. Then one of the team of super, talented Artists (all are volunteers) gets busy to create a totally individual and personal design, according to the wishes of the child. Anne concluded by showing us a video of some the children receiving their own personally designed shoes and it was truly moving to see the delight on the children's faces, and thank you, Anne, for delighting us too!

Our next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday,. 10<sup>th</sup> October in the Memorial Hall at 7.15 pm when Delia Taylor will tell us about "The Golden Age of Hollywood" and the competition will be "Something Coloured like a Rainbow".

### **Woodchurch Local History Society**

Our society meets on the first Monday of the month in the Memorial Hall at 7:30pm.
There has been a change of plan for our October 2nd meeting - our scheduled



speaker is unavailable and instead we have another talk lined up. The presentation is entitled 'George Jarvis - The Mill Smasher of Bethersden'.

George Jarvis was a saw mill owner who operated from Bethersden from about 1870 to 1930. His other business activity resulted in his countywide reputation as a 'mill wrecker' or 'mill smasher'. He was to oversee the demolition of numerous village windmills, some even disappearing overnight.. Sometimes he used the recovered material to repair others.



For instance, the sails or sweeps of a High Halden post mill were used to repair Woodchurch's white mill in 1921.

As mentioned above, our meetings start at 7:30pm and visitors are very welcome (paying £3 at the door). There is no need to book - just turn up on the night.. If you would like to be a half-yearly member this would last until the year end. This would cost £6 and covers the October to December meetings..

### **Presentation of Woodchurch Standard**

The new standard will be on parade again for Remembrance Day and will be seen at future village events supported by The Big Thin Red Line.

NB: Amos Fairbrother was killed in action at the Battle of Arnhem 1944.


